We want to increase student agency in taking control of their own learning,





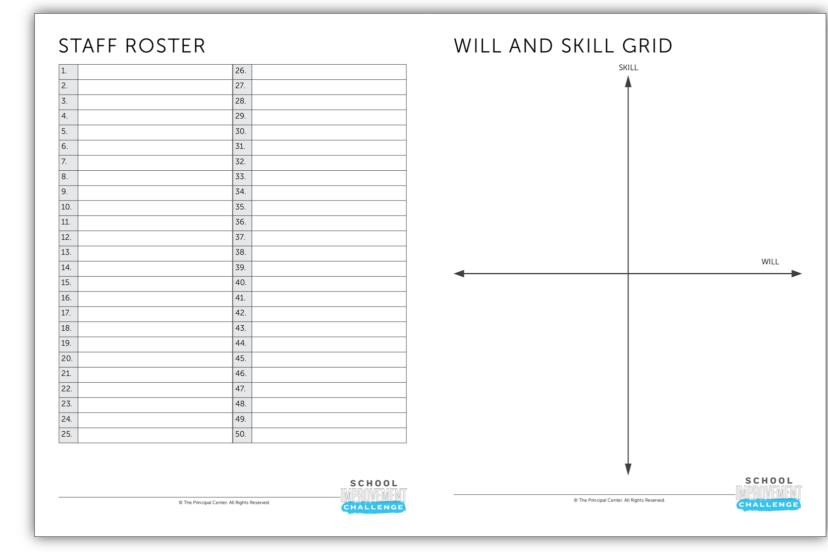

A Few Words of Caution

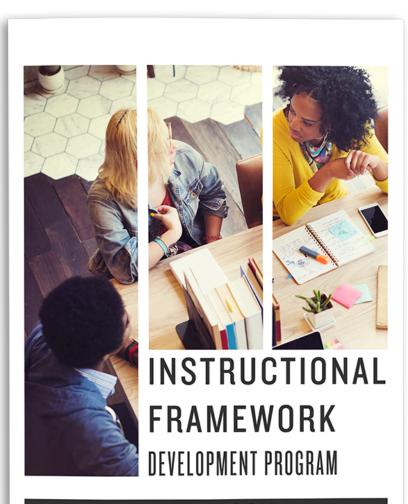
The Instructional Leadership Show ⊕ THE PRINCIPAL CENTER
