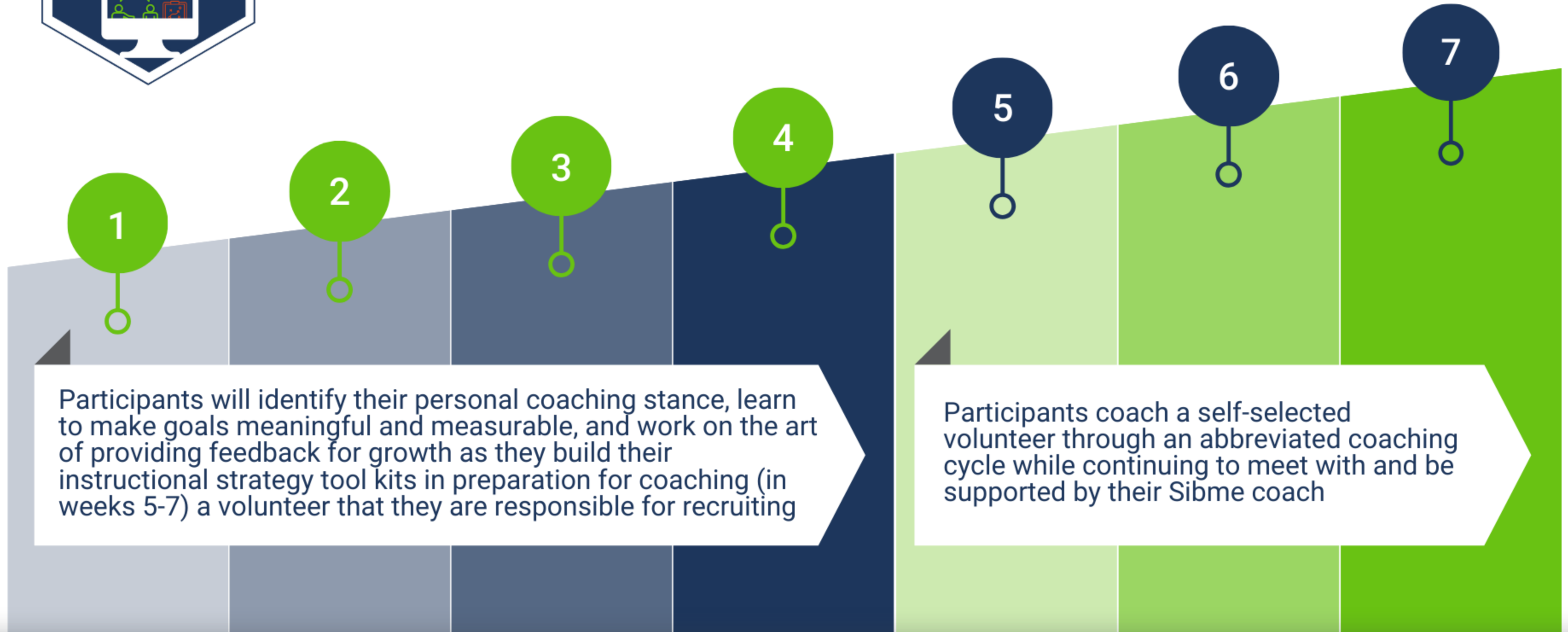

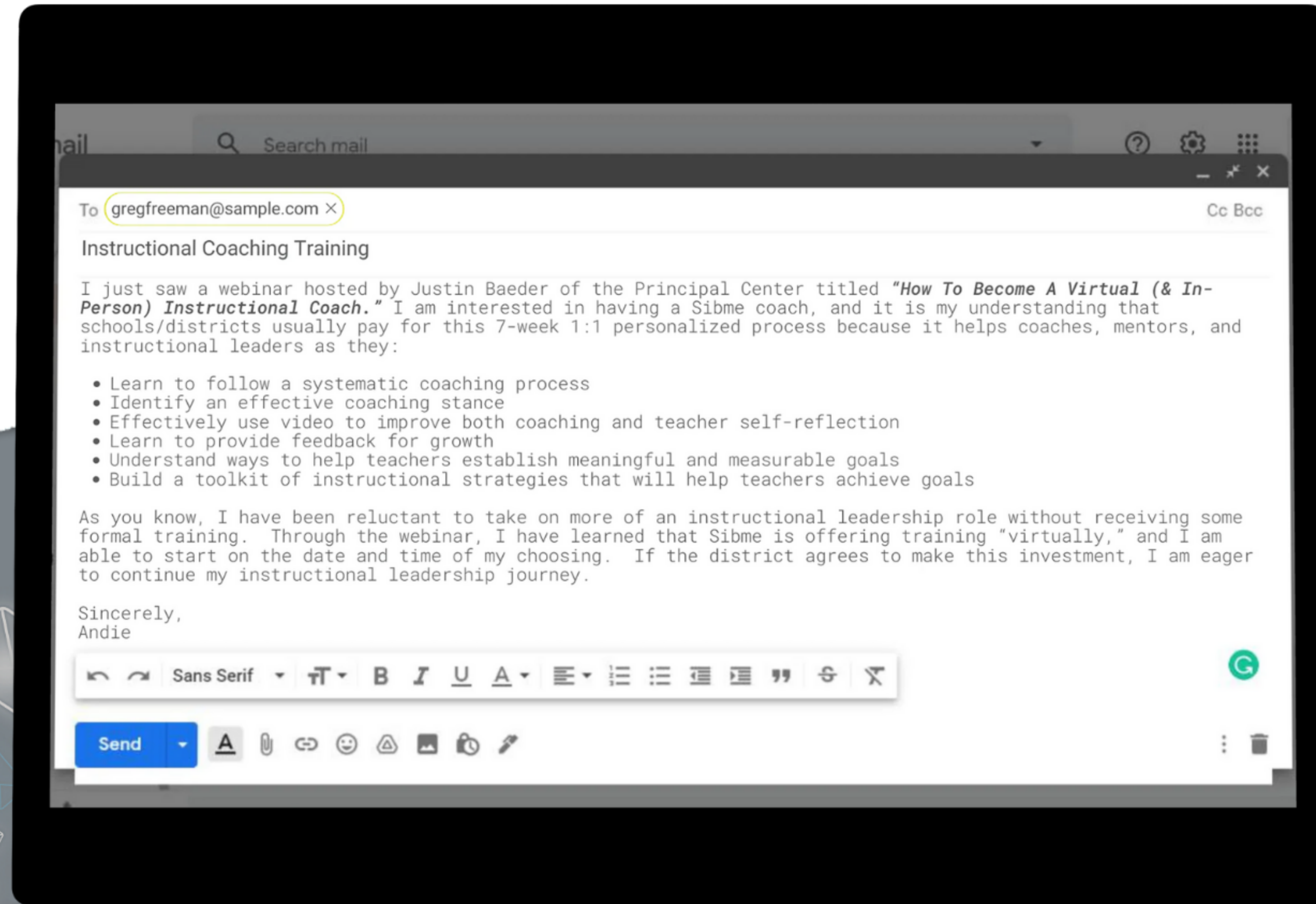
THE SIBME COACHING CYCLE



The 6-Week Personalized Coaching Cycle Includes:

-  Initial contact and overview with the teacher
-  Weekly video conference coaching sessions
-  Review of teacher-submitted "snapshot" videos with time-stamped feedback
-  Goal-related resource sharing and review
-  Weekly emailed coaching reports with progress updates
-  End of cycle touch-point between Sibme coach and teacher supervisor

WHY WE DEVELOPED THIS



What is it?

All great instructional coaches were once great teachers--but not all great teachers are given the necessary support to become great instructional coaches. Sibme developed this coaching solution with one simple goal: help support coaches in order to build their confidence and improve their coaching outcomes.



How long is it and how often do they meet?

- 7 consecutive weeks
- Weekly synchronous, virtual meetings



What's the structure?
